1	16.10 Sat	INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL Departure from the US to TEL AVIV. Dinner and breakfast on board.			
2	 17.10 Sun	Meet and assist by Tailor Made Tours representative with flowers and refreshments at 'Ben Gurion International Airport' in Tel Aviv. Early arrival Shalom and welcome to Israel Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport (time) and meet you Tour Guide and driver. 3	 18.10 Mon	In the morning drive to Megiddo , located on a strategic crossroads, this site has seen habitation from per-historic times. See the remains of Solomon's Stables. Drive to Nazareth on our way to the shores of the Sea of Galilee Nazareth Village. Have a 1st Century lunch. Drive to Zippori to see the unique mosaics including the mysterious "Mona Lisa of the Galilee". Overnight: near the Sea of Galilee.	BLD	Bus and Tour Guide	Tiberius
4	 19.10 Tue	Start the day driving on to the seaside biblical town of Capernaum it was in Capernaum where Jesus made his ministry headquarters. After a cruise on the Sea of Galilee from Tiberius to Kibbutz Ginosar. After landing see the " Jesus Boat ". This particular archaeological find is believed to be from the first century and was discovered during a drought and had been buried for 2000 years on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. This fishing boat is similar to the vessel described in the Gospels, which carried Jesus and his apostles. Next drive to the village of Magdala , which was the home of Mary Magdalene. A very important archeological find that has recently been discovered at this fishing village. Visit Betsaida . Overnight: near the Sea of Galilee.	BD	Bus and Tour Guide	Tiberius



5	 20.10 Wed	<p>Pause on the Mount of Beatitudes, site of the "Sermon on the Mount" to pray and meditate.</p> <p>Travel to Caesarea Philippi and see one of the sources of the Jordan River</p> <p>Later, explore Tel Dan to tour the High Place, attributed to the time of King Jeroboam and the Israelite and Canaanite city gates</p> <p>Continue to the eastern heights above the Sea of Galilee and ascend to the Golan and visit The Valley of Tears to learn about the strategic importance of the Golan Heights and what role is played during the Six Day War and the Yom Kippur War. (not Including Movie) We then continue to Mount Bental for an observation point overlooking the borders of Israel, Lebanon and Syria as well as the "Road to Damascus" (Acts 9) incident and the fateful journey and conversion of Saul, who became better known as the Apostle Paul.</p> <p>Overnight: near the Sea of Galilee.</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Tiberius
6	 21.10 Thu	<p>Depart the Sea of Galilee region and drive to Yardenit, Baptismal site in the Jordan River, (time permitting for anyone wanting to be baptized). Continue south to the renovated ancient city of Scytopolis (Bet Shen), with interesting history and some of the most extensive archeological digs in Israel.</p> <p>Visit the Memorial to the Holocaust – Yad Vashem. Walk along the Avenue of the Righteous, tour the Historical Museum and the Children's Memorial.</p> <p>View Mt. Herzl.</p> <p>Return to Jerusalem and end the day at the Israel Museum (Shrine of the book) to see the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Model of Jerusalem from Jesus' time. This is an important tool in understanding the Old City. Bobby has a list of artifacts that he wants to see in the Museum.</p> <p>Overnight: Jerusalem</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Jerusalem
7	 22.10 Fri	<p>Enjoy the most spectacular view over the city of Jerusalem from atop the Mount of Olives.</p> <p>Descend to Gethsemane via the Chapel of Dominus Flevit and visit the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations.</p> <p>In the evening join thousands of Jewish People of all ages and background as they head to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest place to welcome the Shabbat.</p> <p>Overnight: Jerusalem</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Jerusalem
8	 23.10 Sat	<p>Enter the Old City via St. Stephan's Gate</p> <p>Walk along the Via Dolorosa, from the Pools of Bethesda, After to a short visit of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.</p> <p>Stroll the Old City alleys and explore the Oriental Bazaar (Suk), where haggling has been raised to an art.</p> <p>Drive to Bethlehem to the Church of the Nativity, Manger</p> <p>Kondo shop-own arrangement.</p> <p>Overnight: Jerusalem</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Jerusalem



9	 24.10 Sun	<p>This morning ascend to the Temple Mount (pending security situation) and then Davidson Center.</p> <p>Or explore the newly opened Drainage Tunnel that leads from the city of David to the Southern Wall Excavations.</p> <p>Descend the Western Hill to the City of David to discover the "original" Jerusalem. Walk through the Hezekiah Tunnel, dug in biblical times to bring water to Jerusalem. The engineering was so well executed that it still works today so prepare to get wet! Visit pools of Siloam.</p> <p>Enter the Jewish Quarter to see the Cardo, an 1800-year-old shopping mall still in use today, the Broad Wall (dating back to the 1st Temple period.</p> <p>Enjoy a spiritual visit to the Western Wall, the holiest place of the Jewish People.</p> <p>Explore the Western Wall Tunnels Stretching under the Old City</p> <p>Overnight: Jerusalem</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Jerusalem
10	 25.10 Mon	<p>After breakfast leave Jerusalem to visit Samaria.</p> <p>Visit Tel Shiloh to explore ancient Shiloh including a fascinating multi-sensory Movie.</p> <p>Continue to Mt. Gerizim, after a tour of the site; meet with a representative of the Samaritans for an introduction about their beliefs and way of life.</p>	BD	<i>Bus and Tour Guide</i>	Jerusalem
11	 26.10 Tue	<p>Start the day with Descend to the lowest place on Earth to visit Masada Ascend the mighty cliff of Masada to see the unique hideout palaces built by Herod the Great.
