This annual program offers the ideal platform for those who wish to serve as advocates for Israel in the nations. The combination of curriculum—presented by a lineup of Bridges for Peace senior leaders and prominent Israeli role players in the political, religious, defense, societal, advocacy and historical landscape—and guided visits to sites of biblical significance has been tailor-made to equip and empower delegates with the crucial knowledge and hands-on experience to take up the task of speaking and teaching on the importance of Christians standing with Israel. It also serves as a key accreditation required for those who wish to serve as a Bridges for Peace representative through any one of our national offices.

- Connect delegates with Israeli society through a diverse lineup of speakers and experiences.
- Provide insight into the unique role Bridges for Peace plays through its education initiatives and projects that portray God's love and mercy to the people of Israel.

The price includes:

The price excludes:

- Airfare
- Meeting and assistance on arrival and departure at Ben Gurion Airport
- Arrival and departure transport
- Expenses of a personal nature
- Lunches
- Airport taxes, border taxes and visa fees

Payment Terms and Conditions

Two months prior to the participant's arrival 50% of the total amount (US \$1,360) is to be paid. One month prior to the participant's arrival the total balance is to be paid in full.

Arrival and Check-in

All participants must arrive by Sunday, May 10, in time for dinner at 19:00 (7:00 p.m.) and orientation at 20:00 (8:00 p.m.). Departures should be scheduled for Friday, May 22. Checkout time at the Ramada Hotel is 11:00 a.m.

Please note that we are able to assist should accommodation be required prior to May 10 and/or after May 22. We are, however, limited by the availability of rooms at the hotel. No pre-arrivals/extensions are included in the cost. Additional cost details will be provided on request.

Term Paper

A requirement for participation in the Institute of Israel Studies is the submission of a research paper on an Israel-related topic. Please note that the deadline for submitting the paper is Tuesday, April 14, 2020. Further details will be provided upon completion of the registration process.

MIUD Seminar Extension

After Institute there is an option to attend a Masters International University of Divinity Seminar course. A student of MIUD, can earn through this Institute of Israel Studies (9 credits) and the follow-on course (3 credits) a total of 12 credits. Further details on the course will be provided shortly.

The hotel cost for the MIUD extension May 22 - 24 is US \$130 per person for a shared double room. Single supplement is US \$235. It will include 3 nights (May 21, 22, 23), breakfast and dinner and the meeting room. The course will be held on Saturday, May 23.
