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The most impactful moment for myself in these past months has been the friendships that I have developed. And not with just the other Zealous Israel Project members but also with all the volunteers at Bridges For Peace; both the long and short term volunteers. They have had such an impact on my life and it's something that I don't think I could have gotten anywhere else.

The best excursion so far has been the trip to the Golan Heights and Mount Hermon. I loved seeing a side of Israel that is so beautiful and different. You get away from the desert and into the rocky and grassy hillsides.

You see the side of Israel that few people ever go out and see. And then you go into Mount Hermon during the winter and all of a sudden you've gone into a snowy and foggy mountainside; it's awesome.

I experienced true community service very recently. I was able to work alongside 3 other volunteers to completely transform a home. When we began the apartment was full of mold, ceiling to floor. But by the end we had everything painted, the mold removed, and the floor clean. It was wonderful to spend 2 days to change a families life for years.
